Broccoli and Beef Stir-Fry

1 pound lean beef
steak, sliced diagonally
across the grain into
thin strips

1 tablespoon plus 1/2
cup stir-fry sauce
1 clove minced garlic

1. Combine 1 tablespoon
stir-fry sauce and minced
garlic in a bowl. Add the
beef strips. Let stand 15
minutes.

2. Heat 1 tablespoon canola
oil in a large skillet or wok.

3. Add beef and stir fry for
one minute. Remove
beef from skillet.

4 tablespoons canola
oil, divided

1 medium red onion,
cut into 1/8 inch dice

1 sweet red pepper, cut
into 1/8 inch dice

1 medium yellow

4. Heat the remaining 3
tablespoons canola oil in
the skillet or wok. Add
vegetables. Stir-fry for
four minutes or until veg-
etables are crisp-tender.

5. Return beef to skillet.

6. Add the remaining 1/2
cup stir-fry sauce and red
pepper flakes. Cook and
stir 1 to 2 minutes longer,
until heated through.

Yield: 8, 1 cup servings
