Recipe of the Month



Pumpkin Apple Muffins

11/4 cups whole-wheat flour 11/4 teaspoons baking soda 1/2 teaspoon salt 11/2 teaspoons ground

ginger ½ teaspoon ground nutmeg

11/4 cups honey 2 large eggs

1½cupsfresh pureed pumpkin 1/2 cup canola oil 2 cups Granny Smith apples, finely chopped

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. In a large Note: Can substitute two cups bowl, combine flours, baking soda, salt and spices. In a small bowl, combine honey, eggs, pumpkin and oil; **stir** into dry ingredients just until moistened. **Fold** in apples. **Fill** greased or paper lined muffin cups, two-thirds full. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes or until muffins test done. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan.

granulated sugar for honey, decrease baking soda by ¼ teaspoon and increase oven temperature to 350 degrees F.

Yield: 18 muffins

Nutritional Analysis: 200 calories, 7 g fat, 0.5 g saturated fat, 35 mg cholesterol. 160 mg sodium, 35 g carbohydrate, 2 g fiber, 20 g sugar, 3 g protein
